

## HARRC Meeting – March 11, 2009

Present were officers Mercik, Whittle, Caulfield, Smithers, Vorhauer, and Hakundy-Jones, coordinator Greene, and member Laverty.

Minutes of the prior meeting were accepted on a motion by Hakundy-Jones, seconded by Caulfield.

Membership report showed 200 members compared to 187 in the previous reporting cycle. The report was accepted on a motion by Smithers, seconded by Caulfield.

Treasurer's Report – Expenses exceeded income for the 2-month period. Biggest expense category was charitable donations: Special Olympics, New Cumberland, EMS, and Cumberland-Perry Domestic Violence Services. The report was accepted on a motion by Hakundy-Jones, seconded by Vorhauer.

### Old Business:

- Newsletter discussion continued. Smithers resigned as newsletter editor; resignation accepted. Consensus is that there is no need to recompile information that is already available on the web site. A recommendation was made that minutes be posted on the web site. We will accept anyone who wants to self-nominate to edit an electronic version of the newsletter.
- Contact Mike Smith to have him contact Jim Carlson at the Patriot News to continue publication of Sunday club runs in the paper. (Hakundy-Jones to contact Smith.)
- Banquet – need speaker.
- Thank you received from Special Olympics for donation.
- Marathon 2009 – YMCA has agreed to take over responsibility for organization. We have agreed to give them \$8000 to do so. Agreement will be signed 3/16 at organizational meeting. HARRC to remain in advisory capacity.

### New Business:

- Greene motioned to donate \$500 to Harrisburg area YMCA when the annual solicitation comes. Mercik seconded the motion.
- Discuss amending the bylaws to change meeting frequency.
